This project is about the significance of the Cornish hedge in our landscape and culture, and there are a variety of events throughout Cornwall in dedicated Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty which may be of interest to WCFPS Members.

The next event is at Cape Cornwall on Thursday 23rd May. This is a **free** day-long session running from 10:30am-3:30pm. This event will involve working alongside a master hedger to restore and rebuild a section of Cornish hedge in the local style, whilst learning more about the hedge's geological, ecological and cultural significance.
